



Use this activity as a preparation for the Family Jigsaw in Callan's Thematic Jigsaws 1 or 2.

Instructions:

One student gets Grid A and another gets Grid B. They sit opposite with a divider between them so they cannot look at each other's sheet.

Each gets a full set of the family words from page 4, cut up into squares.

Student A asks student B, "What's number 1?"

Student B reads, "My father's sister."

Student A searches through the family word squares and places the "aunt" square on the number 1 on the grid.

Student B then asks student A, "What's number 2?"

This continues until all word squares are placed on the grid.

The divider is removed and students check if they have the same words on the same squares.
